

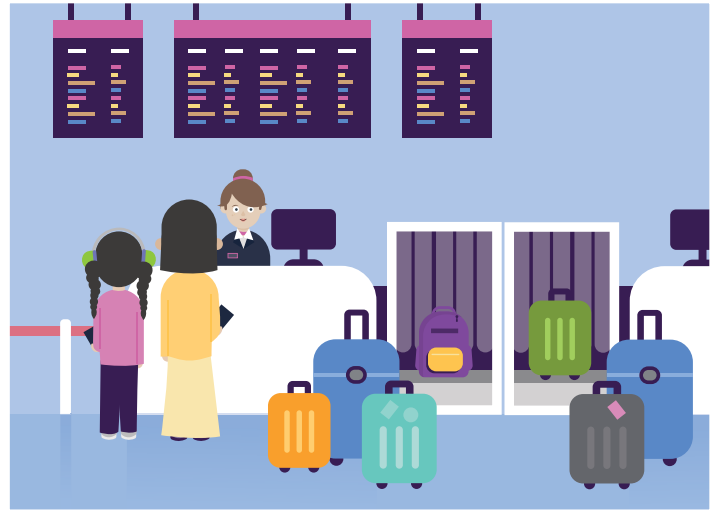
A Social Scenario: Travelling by plane

Once we are through security, we will spend some time waiting in the terminal. While we are waiting, we can:



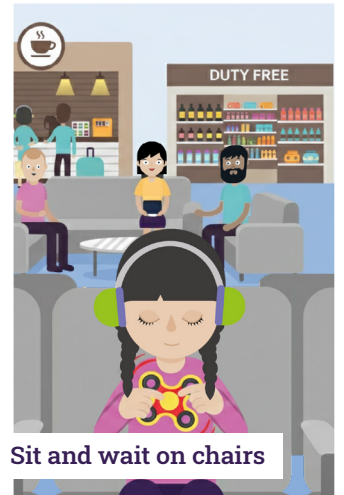
Look around shops

Use the toilet

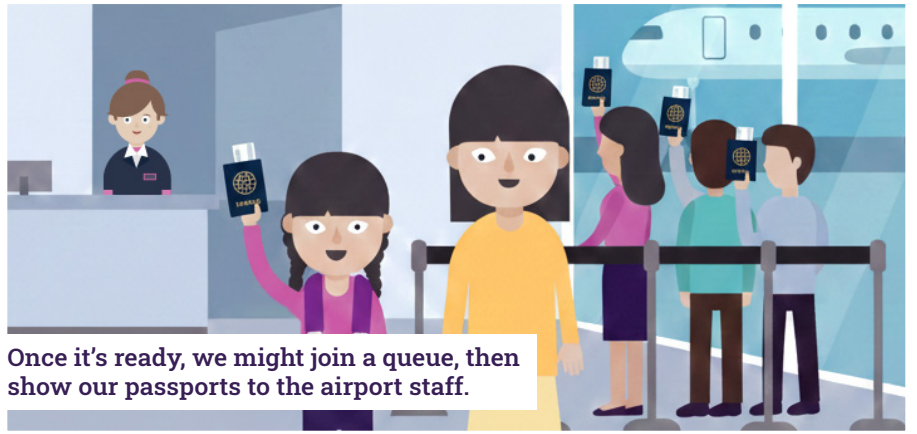


Sit and wait on chairs

When our plane is ready, we will make our way to a gate, where we might have to wait before we board.



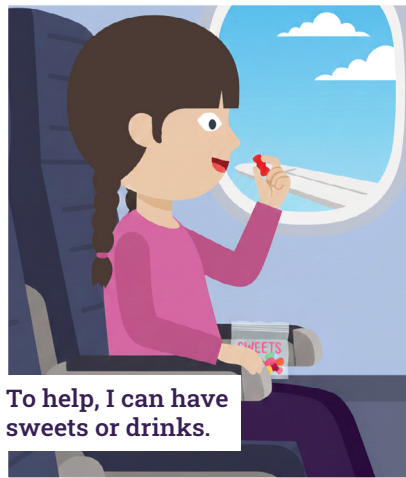
Once it's ready, we might join a queue, then show our passports to the airport staff.

When we get on the plane, we must find our seats, fasten our seatbelts.



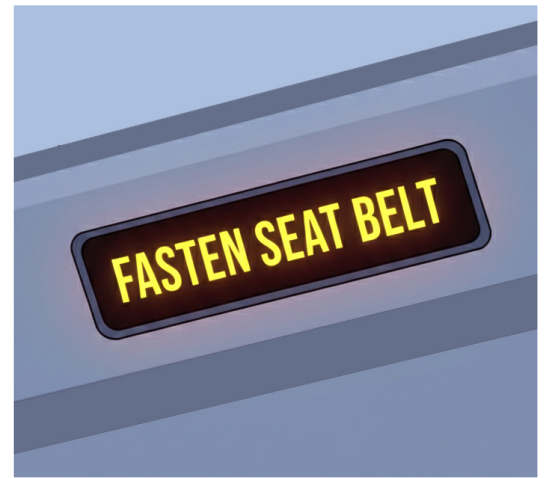
Listen to any instructions given by cabin crew or trusted adult.

When it is time to land, I must stay in my seat.



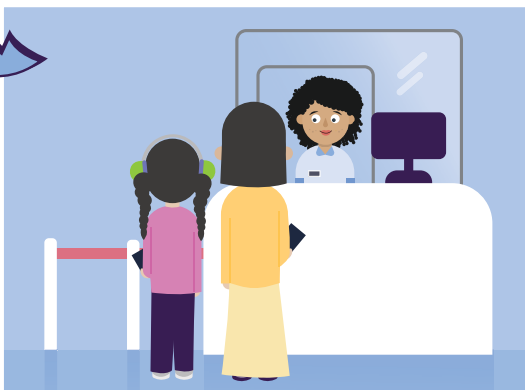
Once we have landed, we must wait our turn to get off. When we get off the aeroplane, we will be going into a new airport.
