Dear Parents and Carers,

As we reach the end of another busy and successful fortnight, I would like to thank everyone who supported our recent Open Day and Art Exhibition.

It was wonderful to welcome so many families into school. Thank you to all those who attended and helped make the day such a success. The school was looking absolutely fantastic, and it was lovely to see classrooms buzzing with pride as children shared their learning with visitors.

Our Art Exhibition was truly stunning and showcased the incredible creativity of our pupils from Nursery through to Year 6. What was particularly impressive was the clear progression in artistic skills and techniques across the school, demonstrating how our curriculum builds knowledge and creativity year upon year. A huge thank you must go to Mrs Le Cornu and Miss Tomas for the tremendous amount of work they put into organising the exhibition, and to all our teachers and support staff who worked so hard to prepare classrooms and displays for Open Day.

Last week, we also welcomed our new Nursery and Reception families into Trinity. Starting school is a significant milestone for both children and parents, and it was a pleasure to meet so many families who will be joining our school community in September.

At the welcome event, our House Captains spoke after my presentation, and I could not have been prouder of them. All four children spoke with confidence, clarity and warmth, sharing their memories, experiences and daily routines at Trinity. They were excellent ambassadors for our school and perfectly reflected the values, kindness and confidence we strive to develop in all our pupils.

Our PTA met last Tuesday, and plans are now well underway for this year's School Fayre, which will take place on **Saturday 27th June from 12:00pm to 3:00pm**. We have lots of exciting activities, stalls and entertainment planned, and we hope it will be a wonderful afternoon for our whole community. Today we are delighted to welcome colleagues from schools across the United Kingdom to Trinity. As many of you know, Trinity holds the Inclusion Kitemark and is recognised as a Centre of Excellence for inclusive practice.

In this capacity, we hosted a meeting yesterday for colleagues from schools across Jersey to share our inclusion journey, the work we have undertaken and the impact this has had on our children and families. Today, it is the turn of fellow Centres of Excellence from the UK to visit the Island. The group are spending the morning visiting Les Landes School before joining us at Trinity this afternoon.

We are incredibly proud that the work of our staff and children continues to be recognised beyond Jersey. These opportunities allow us to share our practice, learn from others and continue striving to provide the very best education and support for every child.

**Riley Field Car Park** We would like to take this opportunity to remind all parents and carers about our parking arrangements at Riley Field. As previously communicated, we ask that the parking spaces at the top of the car park are kept for staff. This is not about staff convenience, but about ensuring that we can use the limited space as efficiently as possible. It enables us to manage how many cars can safely fit on site and allows staff to park in a way where we know vehicles may need to be blocked in if required.

This arrangement is especially important during the winter months, when many staff leave the site in the dark. In line with our lone worker policy, we aim to ensure that staff are able to access their vehicles in a safe and well-considered area.

We would also ask that parents and carers are mindful not to block staff cars at the end of the school day when staying to use Riley Field. Staff often need to leave promptly at 3pm to attend meetings, training courses, or other professional commitments. Your co-operation in keeping access clear is greatly appreciated.

We have also received a number of concerns, regarding smoking in the car park. While we are not looking to formally enforce a no-smoking policy, we do kindly ask that adults avoid smoking in areas where children and staff are walking through. This helps us maintain a safe and respectful environment for everyone.

We ask that you share this information with others picking up your children. Thank you, as always, for your understanding and continued support as I know parking is always an emotive topic!

**After School Club and Breakfast Club** A reminder to parents that if you require a place at Breakfast Club or After School Club for September, please ensure that you complete and return the booking forms as soon as possible. I will be reviewing the numbers over the weekend and confirming staffing arrangements for both clubs on Monday.

We have already received a very high level of interest in places, which is wonderful to see. As previously communicated, places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. We hope to confirm places at the end of next week or the beginning of the week after. Unfortunately, once we reach our staffing and capacity limits, we may not be able to accommodate additional requests, some days are already looking full, so if you are intending to use either club, please submit your forms promptly to avoid disappointment.

**Summer School** We still have a small number of places available for our Summer School, which will run from 24th August to 4th September. The programme provides a fun, engaging and supportive environment for children during the final weeks of the summer holidays, with a range of activities planned each day.
